

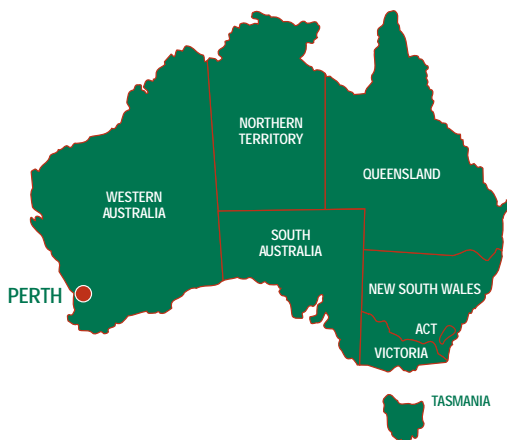

TRANSPORT FROM PERTH

To get to the Fremantle Office from Perth you need to catch a train from the Perth Train Station to the Fremantle Train Station. After you get off at the Fremantle Train Station (it is the last stop on the Fremantle line) get onto the 146 bus. The Fremantle train station and the bus station are located at the same place. The 146 is an hourly service that runs at 5 minutes past the hour from 8am to 2pm. Once on the bus, ask the bus driver to let you off at the bus stop on the corner of Stack and Amherst Streets.

Walk up Stack Street, cross over Wood Street, continue along Stack Street until you come to a large two storey building on your left hand side - that's us!

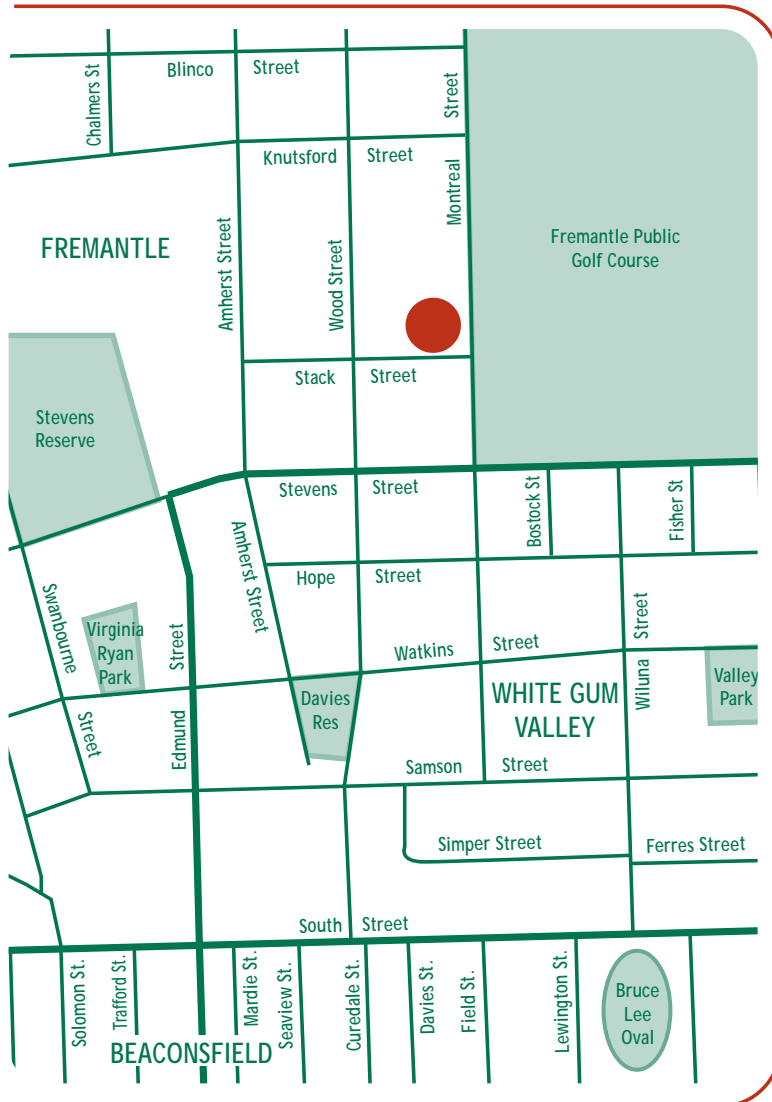
